Lace up your sneakers, pull on your favorite retro camp shirt and get ready for an exciting weekend full of camp activities with other fun-loving adults. From outdoor games and arts & crafts, to singing songs and sharing stories around the evening campfire, this weekend is for anyone who wants to recapture the joy of summer camp. Whether you went to camp as a kid, or just wish you had, everyone is welcome at Camp Rewind. Camp is a special place where relationships are built, memories are made, and community really happens. Bring a friend or make some new ones as we laugh, play, worship and build community as only camp people can!

Here are some things you should know about the weekend:

- **Check-in begins at 4pm on Friday, dinner is at 6pm, and the first activities will begin at 7pm.** You should plan to arrive by 6pm, in time for dinner.
- **Check-out is at 12pm on Sunday.** We ask that guests have all their luggage and personal belongings removed from their guest rooms and keys returned to the front desk by check-out time
- **Travel:** The GPS address for Lutheranch is 344 Salem Church Road, Tallapoosa, Georgia. Once you turn on Salem Church Road, you will see signs for Lutheranch. If you are delayed and will arrive after 7:00 PM, please let us know by contacting Christina Yarnold at 678-857-8501. Note, there is construction on I-20 between Atlanta and Lutheranch. We recommend allowing for extra travel time to compensate for potential delays.
- **Lodging:** Guest accommodations will be provided in our new McKanna-Sandrock Retreat Center (opened in 2017). All rooms are hotel style with 2 queen beds and private bathrooms. If you registered for a Double Room and did not submit a roommate preference during registration, you will have one randomly assigned. If you have a preference, please email our registration office at registration@novusway.org with Camp Rewind Roommate in the subject line and include both your name and the name of your preferred roommate in the body of the email.



- **Meals:** All meals are included in the retreat cost, from dinner on Friday through breakfast on Sunday. Dietary restrictions can be accommodated if we are notified at least 2 weeks in advance.

- **Onsite Activities:** Lutheranch is situated on 519 acres of rolling pastures and woodlands, with 2 lakes and a picturesque creek. In addition to scheduled activities, there will also be free time to explore the property or just relax. One of the best things about going to summer camp as an adult is that YOU get to decide what to do! Here is a sampling of some of the activities available onsite: hiking, swimming, canoeing, kayaking, fishing, archery, gaga ball, volleyball, horseshoes, corn hole, bonfires, group interaction course



- **Plan for a Digital Detox:** Use this weekend as an opportunity to disconnect from technology and connect with those around you. Cell phone coverage is spotty at Lutheranch and our Wi-Fi is satellite based and can be slow.
- **Diversity and Inclusion:** Lutheranch is part of NovusWay Ministries, a non-profit Christian organization affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church of America (ELCA). Our mission is to provide places set apart to inspire all in Christ's love. During Camp Rewind, we will be singing songs about Jesus, saying prayers, sharing Bible stories, and exploring the wonders of God's creation. We invite people of all faiths and cultures to come and experience God's love in community and creation, then go to love and serve.
